Meeting was called to order by President, Tim Sasse.

Opening Devotion and Prayer lead by Judy Zesch.

Motion by Becky, seconded by Vicki to approve the February minutes. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: The 2023 year to date financial report was distributed. The accounts are reconciled through February.

Pastor's Report: Getting ready for an impactful Holy Week, rewriting sermons and creating powerful Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services. Excited about Redemption, God is at work at this place!

March 26th – Passover Meal – 60 people have signed up

May 5th – Pastor attending family confirmation, Pastor Drews will be the visiting Pastor.

May 12th – Music Sunday

May 13th – 15th – Pastor Conference

June 9th - 10 am Combined LCMS Worship Service at Normandale Lake Bandshell. There will be music, food and games for kids/adults. They will need volunteers for this event.

Elder's Report: Nancy Schuett's funeral March 22nd, 11 am at Mt Hope. Starting in the Fall there will be a Movie of the Month, we will watch the movie and discuss it through a Christian lens. There will be a change in serving communion, you can hold out your hand, if you would like the individual cup handed to you. The Elders mandated that all future funerals are to go through the RLC office, have a meeting with Pastor Josh and follow the Funeral Guide, regardless of who is doing the service.

Congregational Life: One remaining lite supper:

March 20th – Leadership will be serving Pizza and donations going to the Musical.

Next game night is April 13th, playing Mario Kart and serving sloppy joes.

Mission Cluster: Easter Fest will be March 23rd (9 -11 am). We will be filling eggs on March 20th, after the church service, set up starting on Friday at 9 am. We are collecting food for Easter Dinners, for Kennedy Families and VEAP.

Resources: Things are calm, there is nothing to report.

Youth: Confirmation date has been changed to May 19th. Discussing joint confirmation starting in the Fall. Jason will be on vacation May 8th – 13th. Deb will answer office phones on May 13th. He will be attending a conference July 20th – 24th. We need technical help for church services on May 12th and July 21st. Also, answering office phones on July 22nd, 23rd & 24th.

Faith Forward: We have a proposal for a 3-year Capital Campaign. The Faith Forward committee will be reformed and more details forthcoming with information to be shared with the members at an upcoming Congregational Meeting. A campaign will move forward once the voters approve of the plan. Capitol Campaign Chairperson is Clara Johnson. It is very important to have a 100% commitment from Leadership and the Capitol Campaign committee. The committee will raise the funds and Robin Pagel will handle all the money. We need to remember this is over and above tithing. Motion by Vicki, seconded by Becky Leadership approves to move forward with the proposal for a 3-year Capitol Campaign. Motion carried. Special thank you to the Faith Forward Committee for all their hard work the past four years.

Safety Committee Chairperson is Phil Pagel, he has an excellent skill set. They will research procedures, plans and grants for possible upgrades.

Nominating Committee Chairperson is Michael Polzin. Becky Kritz is also on the committee. We need nominations for the following elected leaders – Vice President, Treasurer, Mission, Resources, Congregational Life and Elders. Elections will be at the Congregational Meeting on May 19th.

We still need readers and monitors for the Easter Reading Vigil. Please contact Becky Kritz if you are interested or have any questions.

The date of the next Leadership Meeting is April 16, 2024 at 6 pm. Sue will prepare the opening devotion.


